

DO NOT LOAD BAGGAGE AND CARGO **ABOVE THE STRIPED LINE!**

Recent FAA inspections have shown that baggage continues to be loaded above the placarded line in cargo bins of the ERJ170/175 aircraft.

THIS IS UNACCEPTABLE AND MUST STOP IMMEDIATELY.



Placarded lines (as shown below) circle both cargo bins to indicate loading limits inside the cargo bin and are designed for passenger and flight crew safety in the event of a fire. Fire extinguisher nozzles in the ceiling of the cargo bin cannot function effectively if baggage or cargo is loaded above the placarded line. The fire suppression system must have the 2-inch gap to effectively spread the extinguishing agent throughout the cargo bin.
