

# EGOM Revision #7 Changes

Revision #7 to EGOM is effective Friday, June 9, 2017. Changes include, but are not limited to:

- **Page 2-11.VII.A.2.4<sup>th</sup> Bullet – Seat Belt Usage** - Pushback Tractor Only: If view is obstructed by the type of pushback tractor being driven, while driving in reverse, it is permitted to remove the seat belt until the pushback tractor is safely parked.
- **Page 2-46.XVI.B.1. NOTE BOX – Storm Warning**

**Wireless headsets may be utilized during a “Yellow Alert”.**

- **Page 5-22.II.B.3 –Live Animals** - Except for day-old chicks, warm blooded animals will only be accepted when the origin, connecting, and destination temperatures fall between 45°F (7°C) and 85°F (29°C), unless the customer provides a certificate or statement of acclimation signed by an accredited veterinarian. This temperature requirement applies to all animal holding areas such as those at Cargo facilities, PPS facilities, Ramp-side, and ATO/Baggage Service locations.

The temperature for day-old chicks must fall between 45°F (7°C) and 95°F (35°C).

Regardless of the temperatures stated on the certificate or statement of acclimation, live animals will not be accepted when the origin, connecting, and destination temperatures exceed 85°F (29°C) OR fall below 20°F (–7°C).

**NOTE**

**A connecting flight includes shipments tendered on through flights.**

When a live animal is tendered, it is necessary to check the hourly temperatures for every origin, connecting, and destination city to ensure the temperatures are between 45° and 85°F (7°and 29°C).

- **All Aircraft Types – RON Procedures**

**\*\*WARNING\*\***

**All lights, fans, operational system, etc. are required to be turned off prior to the closing of the Main Cabin Door for the night. Employees must ensure that the aircraft is dark and silent prior to closing the Main Cabin Door.**
